Establishment of a National Art School

Objectives:

- To support the creative industries by developing skilled artists and providing new opportunities for youth employment.
- To foster cultural preservation through education in different art forms and promote artistic expression.

Scope:

- International collaboration with partners from Malaysia and Australia to operate and manage the Art School.
- Finalized academic framework, ensuring high standards in creative education.
- Budget requirement for infrastructure setup, including a temporary building for initial intake.

Potential Incentives:

- Exemption from import duties for materials and equipment used in the project.

Envisaged Investment: USD 500 million

Timeline: To be completed within 2 years
