




Promoting Sustainable Floriculture through Local Flower Production

- Reduce dependency on imported ornamental flowers by promoting domestic cultivation of exotic, in-demand varieties for tourism needs.
- Create employment and income opportunities for local communities through flower farming, processing, sales, and tourism-related experiences.

Scope:

- Cultivation of high-demand flowers, particularly orchids, to meet the needs of the growing tourism sector.
- Create a sustainable flower cultivation business that supplies locally grown flowers for use in hotels, resorts, and tourism events.

Potential Incentives:

• Tax benefits and commercial incentives aligned with the government's priorities for food security and agriculture.
