


RasMale' Development – Reclamation and Shore Protection

Objectives:

- Develop RasMale' as a climate-resilient urban settlement with a zero-carbon safe island concept.
- Provide a lasting solution for housing issues in the Greater Male' Area.

Scope:

- Reclamation of 1,153 hectares of land, elevated 3 meters above sea level.
- Shore protection with a focus on beach usage and accessibility.
- Development of a zero-carbon, sustainable urban area, with a focus on climate-proofing and livability.
- Construction of 65,000 housing units across various income levels (social housing, middle-income, and high-end).
- Development of infrastructure such as roads, parks, office buildings, education centers, sports and entertainment zones, hospitals, schools, and commercial areas.
