The Maldives National University (MNU) invites private sector partners to participate in the development of the **MNU Faculty of Agriculture and Food Sciences** in AA. Thoddoo – Maldives' most productive agricultural island.

This opportunity is structured around a contractor-financed model, with flexibility for investors to recover their capital through a combination of deferred government payments and commercial rights. These may include the operation of on-site farms, the sale of agricultural products, and use of training labs for commercial R&D.

Project Overview

The MNU Agricultural College in AA. Thoddoo will serve as the national centre for sustainable agriculture training, value-added food innovation, and agri-entrepreneurship.

The 80,000 sqft government-allocated site will house:

- Main academic block with classrooms, labs, offices
- Student accommodation for 50 students
- Agricultural training fields (Agri-Blocks)
- Operational demonstration and commercial farms
- Food testing laboratories and value-add production units
- A training-based retail farm shop open to the public
